Light & Crisp

01. Pecorino, DeNatile ITALY 🌿	6	8.25	33
This is a dry, refreshing Italian white made from the Pecorino grape. It is bright and citrusy with ripe fruit flavours.			
02. Verdejo Rueda, Azumbre SPAIN			36
Verdejo is Spain's answer to Sauvignon Blanc with its bright, tangy personality. It has loads of va-va-voom with its citrusy and mandarin flavours.			
03. Pique & Mixe Piquepoul-Terret, Vignerons de Florensac FRANCE 🌿	6.40	8.75	35
This is a fun, vivacious Languedoc white with zesty fruitiness and lively acidity. The finish is crisp and citrusy, making for a refreshing style.			

04. Vinho Verde, Quinta da Raza PORTUGAL 🌿			37
This is a thirst-quenching, invigorating wine from the north of Portugal. It's crisp and lively with a delicate spritzy note.			

Aromatic & Fruity

05. Sauvignon Blanc, Echo NEW ZEALAND 🌿🍷	6.40	8.75	35
Refreshing and bright, Echo is a classic Marlborough Sauvignon with ripe, tropical fruit flavours and juicy acidity that will make your mouth water.			
06. Albariño, Veiga da Princesa SPAIN			40
This carefully crafted Albariño hails from the cool Atlantic Galician coastline. It makes a fresh yet weighty white.			
07. Sancerre, Domaine Denizot FRANCE			49
Carefully tended and made, this is a pure, precise and elegant Sancerre. Its beauty is its delicate and tender texture and its fine finish.			

Rich, Fuller & Textured

08. Chardonnay, Le Grand Noir FRANCE 🌿	5.30	7.25	29
Le Grand Noir is satisfying yet fresh. It offers pineapple-like flavours and a subtle hint of oak while a splash of Viognier in the blend brings a hint of something exotic.			
09. Mâcon-Villages La Chânoise, Laurent Savoye FRANCE			40
Pale yellow in colour, this wine offers aromas of citrus fruit and white flowers. The palate is rich and powerful.			
10. Vouvray Empreinte, Alain Robert FRANCE			45
This dry Vouvray is an attractive, pure and tender wine. Delightfully balanced with plenty of apple and pear flavours on the juicy finish.			
11. Riesling Sentiment, Domaine Amélie & Charles Sparr FRANCE 🍷			46
This soulful, biodynamically grown, dry Riesling is all about texture and depth. Hands-off winemaking is key here, creating a wholesome, satisfying white.			

Lighter & Easy Drinking

12. Pinot Noir, Paparuda ROMANIA 🌿	5.45	7.5	30
A juicy, fruit-filled Pinot Noir with a succulent texture that makes for an appealing, easy-drinking red.			
13. Zweigelt, Funkstille AUSTRIA 🌿			35
Kick back and take a moment to enjoy its vibrant fruit flavours and gentle texture.			
14. Fleurie La Cadole, Laurent Savoye FRANCE			44
This Beaujolais Villages may have classically juicy fruit, but it is much more serious in terms of concentration.			

Medium-Bodied, Great All-Rounders

15. Nero d'Avola, Fedele ITALY 🌿🍷	6	8.25	33
Nero d'Avola is native to Sicily and this organically grown red is soft and flavoursome with ripe berry fruit flavours.			
16. Carmenère, Miguel Torres CHILE			35
This organically grown Carmenère grape is rich and smooth, dark and seductive. It boasts black fruits, fennel and a lick of vanilla and spice.			
17. Grand Veneur Côtes du Rhône, Alain Jaume FRANCE 🌿🍷	6.60	9	37
This juicy, medium bodied red is packed with summer fruit flavours that make this immediately appealing.			
18. Passitivo Primitivo, Paolo Leo ITALY 🍷			38
This is a rich and generous style of wine from the heel of Italy's boot. Round yet fresh it has a charming palate filled with red fruit, festive spices and liquorice flavours.			

Bold, Complex & Full-Bodied

19. Malbec, Le Grand Noir FRANCE 🌿	5.30	7.25	29
This southern Malbec combines the best of both worlds: the fruity expression you'd expect in Argentine wines with the subtler, more structured styles from its homeland of Cahors.			
20. Rioja Reserva, Bodegas Ugalde SPAIN			37
This classic Rioja blend is full and round with a succulent texture. Aged to perfection in the traditional way, using American and French barrels, a lick of vanilla joins the ripe berry fruit flavours.			
21. Douro, Altano PORTUGAL 🌿🍷			36
Dark as night in colour, this organic blend is rich yet balanced with black fruit and violet aromas.			
22. Saint Emilion, Château Tour du Pas St Georges, FRANCE			49
Aged in oak for 18 months, this St Emilion is already exhibiting tertiary complexity such as mushroom and forest floor, in addition to vanilla-spiced dark plum and cassis notes.			

Sparkling

23. Prosecco, Botter ITALY 6.50 34

This has everything you would expect from a Prosecco, gently sparkling, refreshingly light and easy to drink.

24. Cremant de Loire Cuvée Flamme, Gratien & Meyer FRANCE 42

Made in the same way as Champagne, this refined sparkling wine hails from the Loire Valley. This is a dry, crisp sparkler with refreshing citrus fruit and apple flavours.

25. Cremant de Loire Cuvée Flamme Rosé, Gratien & Meyer FRANCE 8 42

This sparkling rosé both looks and tastes the part. It is a pretty pink colour, has a fine bubble, and delicious red fruit flavours.

26. Brut Reserve, Gusbourne ENGLAND 12 55

Pale golden in colour, with fine beads of bubbles in the glass. On the nose, aromas of green apple, bright lemon citrus and nectarine.

27. Rosé, Gusbourne ENGLAND 60

Pale pink in colour, with a light, delicate mousse. The nose showcases lots of red fruit and stone fruit notes, citrus zest and fresh flowers.

28. Champagne, Ruinart FRANCE 100

Elegant and complex, this wine opens with delicate notes of reinette apples, apricots, and fresh almonds, followed by hints of elderflower and coriander seed.

Rosé

29. Pinot Grigio Rosé, Villa del Lago ITALY 5.45 7.50 30

This hauntingly pale rosé is crisp and dry with flavours of fresh red berries. It's an easy-drinking, bright style.

30. 'Le Fruit Defendu' Rosé, Famille Bruno Lafon FRANCE 6.40 8.75 35

This is a charming, Provence-like rosé in its pale pink colour and red fruit flavours. But it tastes like it has been loved: hand picked and gently nurtured from grape to glass.

31. Côtes de Provence Rosé, Château Clarettes FRANCE 38

A succulent and fruity Provence rosé full of ripe red berry fruit flavours and floral notes. Gently refreshing and moreish.

Dessert & Fortified

32. 10 Year Old Tawny Port, Graham's PORTUGAL 8

This is a mellow and rich port. As its name suggests, it is a deep shade of amber. The flavours are multi-layered with nutty aromas meeting fig and fruit cake.

33. Sauternes, Carmes de Rieussec (37.5) FRANCE 8.50 40

Sauternes are the world's most famous sweet wines and this is from one of the most renowned estates. While sweet, it is remarkably fresh and offers up toothsome flavours of apricot, orange and a subtle note of sweet vanilla.
